## MCILWRAITH CROQUET CLUB FUNCTIONS FACT SHEET

Thank you for your interest in holding a function at McIlwraith Croquet Club. We're sure you'll have a ball!

### OUR HERITAGE VENUE

Historic McIlwraith Croquet Club overlooks four beautiful playing lawns fringed by gardens and Jacaranda trees.

Our facilities feature an undercover area which is ideal for preparing and serving food, along with a quaint shed which can be used as an outdoor bar area.

Serving tables, white arm chairs and colourful shade gazebos are all included in our venue hire package.

### CAPACITY

We comfortably host between 20\* and 80 guests. (\*We accept bookings for less than 20, however, there is a minimum booking fee of \$400.)

### AVAILABILITY

Functions may be booked on Friday, Saturday and Sunday afternoons.

### VENUE HIRE

Venue hire is based on \$20 per head for a period of four (4) hours.

### Deposit

After your booking is confirmed, a non-refundable deposit of \$200 is required within 10 days.

### CANCELLATIONS

#### Cancellation due to weather

We are happy to transfer your booking to another date, subject to availability.

### EQUIPMENT PROVIDED

Equipment included in our venue hire package:

- 6 trestle tables
- 4 teak tables (90cm square)
- 60 white outdoor arm chairs
- 4 marquees (3m x 3m in red, green, blue, yellow)
- 1 marquee (6m x 3m in blue)
- Access to fridge under the Clubhouse.

### Available for hire

- One flat plate gas BBQ and one Weber BBQ are available for hire at \$20 each.

Replacement costs will be charged in the event of damage to club equipment and facilities.

### WHAT YOU NEED TO BRING

- Food and beverages are not included in venue hire costs. Our Functions Coordinator is happy to help with suggestions .
- We are not licenced. BYO all drinks and alcohol.
- You will need to bring your own glasses, plates, cutlery, serving platters.
- You will need to clean up and dispose of all litter.
- Cans and bottles may be recycled on site.

### ON THE DAY

- Marquees and chairs will be arranged, as agreed and we will take them down at the end of the function.
- Lawns will be set up ready for play along with a range of mallets.
- Members will be on hand to introduce guests to the game of croquet.
- Flat shoes or sandals, a hat and sunscreen are recommended for guests.
- Wearing pants or shorts also may make mallet swinging easier.
